MBBS & BDS ADMISSIONS – 2016

Refer the website regularly for updated and relevant information.

Centralized admissions to different Private Medical, Dental colleges in Rajasthan who have opted for admission in MBBS / BDS course through counseling by Federation (List available on website) for the session 2016-17 shall be made in the following courses:

1. **Bachelor of Medicine; Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS)** The duration of MBBS course is 4.5 years followed by compulsory internship of one year.
2. **Bachelor of Dental Surgery (BDS)** The course is divided into 4 years of training and 1 year compulsory rotatory internship.

Please read carefully information booklet, instructions for filling the online application form, seat matrix & notification available at the website www.fpmdcr.com, before you start filling the registration form on-line.

The NEET 2016 has been conducted for 85% seats in Private Medical / Dental Colleges who have opted to fill the seats in the respective colleges through Federation of Private Medical and Dental Colleges of Rajasthan, as per the rules and regulations laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India & State Government.

The allotments will be done by the Admission Board comprising of Principals of Medical / Dental Colleges of the state that have opted for the same.

During the process, the eligibility criteria, relevant documents, etc. of the candidates shall be verified and Medical / Dental College shall be allotted to the candidate according to the merit, the choice(s) filled by the candidate and availability of the seats as per the reservation policy of the state.

REGISTRATION FEE

All candidates are required to deposit non-refundable registration fee of Rs. 2000/- in the form of Demand draft drawn in favor of Federation of Private Medical and Dental Colleges of Rajasthan, payable at Udaipur (Raj.)

The registration fee is neither refundable, nor transferable and nor adjustable for any future FPMDCR UG admissions. Any plea in this matter shall not be entertained.

Please keep the information submitted in application form confidential and do not share with anybody. If you don't apply during registration period, you will not be eligible to appear in the counseling. Please also note that registration will be available once only, before allotment of round-I, during period specified in Schedule.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. Education Qualification

No candidate shall be allowed to be admitted to the MBBS or BDS course until he or she has passed the qualifying examination as under:

MBBS	BDS
The Senior Secondary examination or the Indian School Certificate Examination, which is equivalent to 10+2 after a period of 12 years study, the last 2 years of study must comprise of Physics, Chemistry, Biology / Biotechnology with English as compulsory subject.	The Senior Secondary examination or the Indian School Certificate Examination, which is equivalent to 10+2 after a period of 12 years study, the last 2 years of study must comprise of Physics, Chemistry, Biology with English as compulsory subject.

Note: Where the Course content is not as prescribed for 10+2 educational structure of the National Committee, the candidate will have to undergo period of one year Pre-Professional training before admission to Medical Colleges. The Pre-Professional Course may be conducted either at a Medical College or a Science College.

A candidate must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology / Biotechnology and English individually and must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry & Biology / Biotechnology at the qualifying examination and in addition must have obtained minimum of 50 percentile and come in the merit list as a result of such competitive entrance examination (NEET 2016).

In respect of candidate belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes and Special Backward Classes, a candidate must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology / Biotechnology and English individually and must have obtained a minimum of 40% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry & Biology / Biotechnology at the qualifying examination and in addition must have

obtained minimum of 40 percentile and come in the merit list as a result of such competitive entrance examination (NEET 2016).

Further, a candidate with locomotor disability of lower limbs must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology / Biotechnology and English individually and must have obtained a minimum of 45% marks for General PH and 40% marks for SC-PH/ST-PH/OBC-PH/SBC-PH taken together in Physics, Chemistry & Biology / Biotechnology at the qualifying examination and in addition must have obtained a minimum of 45 percentile for General PH and 40 percentile for SC-PH/ST-PH/OBC-PH/SBC-PH and come in the merit list as a result of such competitive entrance examination (NEET 2016).

2. Age Limit

Minimum 17 years on or before 31st December 2016.

3. RESERVATION

Reservation policy as per guidelines of Government from time to time for admission in MBBS / BDS Course will be followed by the Federation during allotment of seats in respective course

4. SEATS

The total number of seats in the member colleges / institutes of Federation of Private Medical and Dental Colleges of Rajasthan are available at the website www.fpmdcr.com.

5. APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Before filling the on-line registration form, read the information booklet and instructions for filling on-line registration form etc. very carefully.

You should be very careful in filling-up the on-line application form. If any lapse is detected during the scrutiny, your candidature will be rejected even if you come through the final stage of admission process or even at a later stage.

Instructions to the Candidates for Filling the Application Form:

Follow the steps as given in "Instructions to fill up online application form" available at the website.

Note: Details of the Demand Draft of Rs. 2000/- is mandatory for filling the application form.

- Candidate interested in appearing for the FPMDCR – UG NEET 2016 Counseling has to fill the Application Form on the website: www.fmpdcr.com
- All the fields in Application Form are mandatory to fill and candidate has to be careful while filling the online application form.
- The candidate can edit the details entered by him/her in the Application Form until he/she clicks the “Submit” Button for final submission of application form.
- Once the candidate clicks the “Submit” Button, he/she will not be able to edit the entered data. Therefore, the candidates are advised to click “Submit” button only and only if he/she is sure that the Data entered in the Online Application Form are correct and no further editing is required.
- Candidate is required to upload his/her recent passport size photograph (not older than 3 months) and signature as per the facility provided on the web portal of the online application form. Ensure that the image size of photograph should not exceed 25 KB (maximum) in the JPEG/JPG File Format and the image size of Signature should not exceed 15 KB (maximum) in the JPEG/JPG File Format.
- The Office of the Federation will not be responsible for any consequence arising out of non-acceptance of any correction/addition/deletion of any Data of the application form after clicking the “Submit” Button.
- It is compulsory to send hard copy (printout) of application form along with the self-attested copies of relevant certificates and requisite fee as mentioned in the check list by Speed Post / Registered Post / Courier or by hand on the following address on or before 06.09.2016 (5:00 PM)

Keep the following ready before you start filling the online application form:

Mandatory documents uploading for all candidates

1. Scanned copy of your recent passport size coloured photo (taken on or after 01-01-2016) in the prescribed format (jpg or jpeg, size preferably upto maximum 40 KB)
2. Scanned copy of your signature in the prescribed format (jpg or jpeg, size preferably upto maximum 40 KB) Be very careful while scanning your signature. You should first put your signature in an area of about 2" × 1" on blank paper with a ball point pen. Scan this paper. Cut/ select only signature area (2" × 1") and save it as jpg or jpeg (do not upload your signature in A4 size format / full paper).
3. Scanned copy of NEET Score Card in format (jpg or jpeg, size preferably upto maximum 150 KB).
4. Scanned copy of Xth marksheet in format (jpg or jpeg, size preferably upto maximum 150 KB).
5. Scanned copy of XIIth marksheet in format (jpg or jpeg, size preferably upto maximum 150 KB).
6. Scanned copy of Date of Birth Proof (Preferably 10th Marksheet) in format (jpg or jpeg, size preferably upto maximum 150 KB).
7. Scanned copy of your caste certificate (if applicable) in the applicable proforma and in format (jpg or jpeg, size preferably upto maximum 150 KB).
8. Scanned copy of PH category certificate (if applicable) in the applicable proforma (available at the website) and in format (jpg or jpeg, size preferably upto maximum 150 KB)

9. Scanned copy of ID Proof (driving licence / PAN card / Voter ID / Govt, or PSU card / School ID card / 12th class examination admit card / Aadhaar card) in format (jpg or jpeg, size preferably upto maximum 150 KB).

Do not make any mistake in uploading the above documents.

You should make sure of your eligibility etc. and that the declaration made by you in the format of application regarding your eligibility is correct in all respects. You will be liable to any legal action and / or punishment as may be deemed fit by the Admission Board in case it is found that you have furnished in-correct information or made false declaration regarding your eligibility at any stage or suppressed any information.

The jurisdiction for legal cases arising out of Rajasthan MBBS & BDS Admissions 2016 shall be limited to the High Court of Rajasthan.

The decision of the Admission Board in all aspects and all respects pertaining to the application and its acceptance or rejection as the case may be, conduct of counseling and at all consequent stages culminating in the admission or otherwise of any candidate shall be final in all respects and binding on all concerned.

The admission board reserves its right to alter and modify time and conditions laid down in the notification, information booklet for conducting the various stages up to the admission, duly intimating details thereof on the website, as warranted by any unforeseen circumstances arising during the course of this process, or as deemed necessary by the admission board at any stage.

ALLOTMENT OF SEATS THROUGH COUNSELLING

Allotment of seats through counseling of all successful and registered candidates through NEET 2016 result shall be conducted for all the candidates who has applied for FPMDCR - UG NEET 2016 Counseling, strictly in accordance with the merit list prepared on the basis of marks in NEET 2016 (and within same marks on the basis of 10+2 marks in science subjects, no. of attempts in 10+2 and marks in 10th class). Provided that if any candidate is not able to report for counseling on the notified date on medical grounds or due to some other circumstances beyond his/her control and his/her parent/guardian comes in person on his/her behalf for counseling with the copy of certificates he/she will be considered for provisional admission.

The merit shall be considered corresponding to minimum percentile obtained in NEET 2016 for all categories.

GEN PH	45 percentile and above (131 marks and above)
OBC NCL	40 percentile and above (118 marks and above)
SBC NCL	40 percentile and above (118 marks and above)

ST	40 percentile and above (118 marks and above)
ST-STA	40 percentile and above (118 marks and above)
CATEGORY PH	40 percentile and above (118 marks and above)

The selected candidates should bring the requisite documents in original along with attested copies of documents for verification, at the time of counseling / admission to the allotted college, failing which admission shall stand cancelled.

SELECTION OF STUDENTS

- (i) The allotment of students to Medical / Dental Colleges shall be based solely on the All India merit of the candidate through NEET 2016.
- (ii) The eligible passed candidates in the NEET 2016 will be admitted in the order of merit for the general as well as reserved seats.
- (iii) Candidates securing equal percentile in the NEET 2016 will be admitted in the following order of preference:

- (a) One who has secured more marks in the science subjects of 10+2 or its equivalent qualifying examination.
- (b) One who has passed in lesser number of attempts in 10+2 or its equivalent qualifying examination.
- (c) The candidate of higher age (older candidate).

Bank Guarantee/Cash Security:-

The selected candidates may also required to submit Bank Guarantee/Cash Security for remaining years of the total course at the time of getting admission before last date of fee deposition in the first year of MBBS / BDS course.

REPORTING TO COLLEGE AFTER COUNSELLING/JOINING TIME

Each candidate shall be given the time as mentioned in the allotment letter, issued on line, to join the allotted college and course. There is no provision of extension for joining date under any circumstances. The allotment made will be firm and final. Change of college/course from one place to another is not permitted. Therefore, request for the same would not be entertained by the Admission Board after the allotment, except the candidate can opt for 2nd round for change of college/course as per allotment.

The candidates who do not join the allotted college in the first round of counselling will be in-eligible to be considered for all subsequent rounds of counselling.

While reporting for admission, please carry all the relevant certificates/documents in original. These original documents may be kept with the institution till completion of the course.

The fact that a candidate has appeared for allotment shall not entitle him/her for allotment reallocation as the same will be subject to availability of seat and acceptance of the available seats at the rank of the candidate by him/her.

The selected candidates will be required to undergo medical examination at the Institutions on the notified date(s).

Provided that if any candidate is not able to report for Medical Examination at the Institution on the notified date on medical grounds or due to some other circumstances beyond his/her control and his/her parent/guardian comes in person on his/her behalf for verification of the original certificates to the college he/she will be considered for provisional admission. His / Her formal admission will be confirmed only when

he/she is found medically fit and fulfills other requirements before the date of commencement of the class.

Candidates who fail to attend medical examination on the notified date are liable to forfeit the claim for admission and will not be considered eligible for 2nd round.

Candidates who have been admitted must join their classes on the date to be notified after admission.

The selection for this admission will be cancelled if the selected candidates do not report to the allotted college and deposit fees upto the stipulated date or whose particulars are not found correct or who are found medically unfit.

The candidates must present the **accepted resignation** from the institution he / she is pursuing studies at present at time of reporting. Failure to do so will result in disqualification for admission.

The selected candidates must also carry all requisite certificates / documents in original along with self-attested copies of the same for verification, at the time of reporting at the allotted college, failing which their admission shall stand cancelled. These original documents shall be kept with the institution till completion of the course.

A candidate without **Original certificates / documents** shall not be allowed to take admission at the allotted college under any circumstances. A candidate who has already been admitted in MBBS course and has deposited his / her certificates in any medical college/ institute / university and comes for on-line/ off-line counselling (allotment process) with a certificate stating that "his/her original certificates are deposited with the medical college / institute / university" (except the college allotted through Rajasthan state process), will **NOT** be allowed to take admission at the allotted college.

The colleges shall be provided the list of candidates allotted. The colleges shall verify the credentials of reporting candidates as per this list and check the documents and other required certificates with originals.

The admissions shall be treated as provisional subject to the final decision of any pending case(s) in any court of law, if applicable to these admissions. Further, the provisional status of admission shall stand cleared only after enrolment by the concerned University.

The non-viewing of the websites about allotment information by the candidate shall not be accepted as a ground for non-reporting at the allotted college on the scheduled time and date. The candidate's allotment will stand automatically cancelled if he/she does not report IN PERSON to the allotted college as per the notified schedule.

IMPERSONATION

If at any stage, It Is found that any candidate has indulged In any case of Impersonation I.e. not matching the photograph/signature/video graph/documents of the candidate etc. he/she will be handed over to the Police and the cases will be dealt as per the Indian Penal Code In this matter and If required, the cases will be handed over to Police for further investigation.

Such candidates will be debarred permanently from taking MBBS/BDS Admissions In Future.

The apex court drew guidelines for the management of all educational Institutions to follow. Among them:

Educational Institutions should take anti-ragging measures right from the time of advertisement for admissions. The prospectus, the form for admission and/or any other literature issued to aspirants for admission must clearly mention that ragging Is banned in the institution and anyone Indulging in It Is likely to be punished appropriately which may include expulsion from the institution, suspension from the Institution or classes for a limited period or fine with a public apology.

The punishment may also take the shape of: (i) withholding scholarships or other benefits (ii) debarring from representation in events (Hi) withholding results (Iv) suspension or expulsion from hostel or mess. If there be any legislation governing ragging or any provisions in statute/ordinance, It should be brought to the notice of the students/parents seeking admissions. A printed leaflet detailing when and to whom a victim may turn for information, help and guidance for various purposes, keeping in view the needs of new entrants, along with their addresses and telephone numbers should be given to fresher at the time of admissions so that they need not to look to seniors for help in such matters.
